Background

- Second priority in Capital Plan for new schools
- Kelowna Secondary School enrolment could go beyond 2,400 students within ten years
- All existing space in Kelowna secondary schools full by 2025
- 41 portables are in the Central Kelowna Family of schools
- 15% of students in the Glenmore Neighbourhood of Kelowna are in portables
- A new secondary school would enable consistent grade configuration throughout the district
