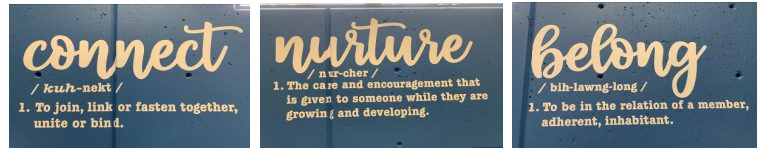

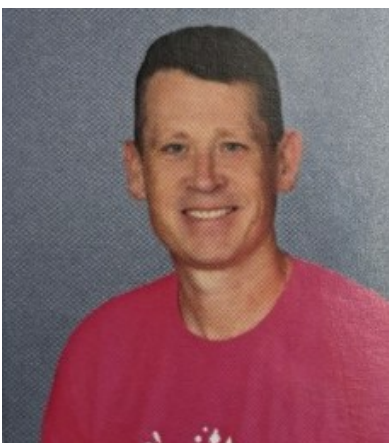

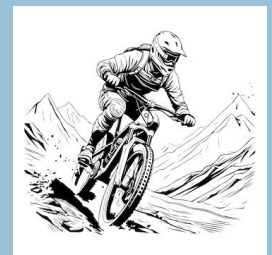

UBCO Heat Volleyball invites athletes from grades 7-12 to form teams from within their schools to compete in the 2026 Okanagan School Grass Volleyball Championships!

WHEN: Friday June 12, 2026 (preliminary schedule 9am - 4pm)
WHERE: Kelowna City Park (north field)
COST: \$108 per team (collected later)

Eligibility and Team Composition:

- All matches will be played 4 on 4.
- Teams can have a maximum of 5 players who can rotate during/between matches
- All athletes on a team must be from the same school
- Athletes may only play on 1 team
- All schools must have an adult supervisor present and designated as a contact for their teams. A supervisor can be responsible for more than 1 team from the same school and does not have to be a teacher.

Divisions Available:

- Senior Boys (Grades 11-12)
- Junior Boys (Grade 9-10)
- Grade 7/8 Boys (Grade 7-8)
- Senior Girls (Grades 11-12)
- Junior Girls (Grades 9-10)
- Grade 7/8 Girls (Grade 7-8)

*Teams must be composed of players in the same age/grade category and register to play in their respective division.

Tournament Format:

- All matches will be two 10-minute timed sets
- Teams will self-referee and be responsible for scorekeeping
- Teams are guaranteed 5 matches
- Prizes for top teams
