

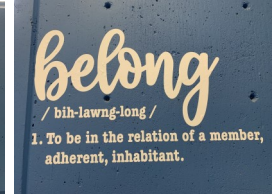
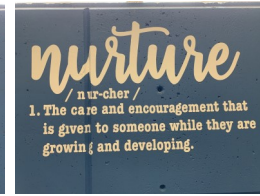

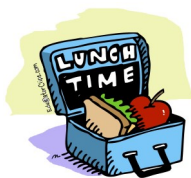
Happy Friday, everyone!
