Constable Neil Bruce Middle School owns a fleet of instruments available for rent to students. These instruments are rented at a much lower rate than the annual rental fee from a retail music store to make Band more affordable to CNB families. If your family needs financial assistance to make the Band program accessible, the school can access hardship funds and lend you an instrument for the year.

Another option for families is to privately rent or purchase (you will be provided with info in the fall about how to do this). Instruments rented privately through Wentworth Music or Tapestry Music will be significantly more expensive, but the programs are rent-to-own and the instruments are newer. When you rent through a store, your repairs are covered through that fee (insurance is included).

The annual rental fees for an instrument through School District 23 and CNB are as follows:

\$120/year: Flute, Clarinet, Trumpet, Trombone, Electric Guitar, and Electric Bass

\$150/year: Oboe, Bassoon, Bass Clarinet, Alto Sax, Tenor Sax, French Horn, Baritone/Euphonium

\$180/year: Baritone Sax, Tuba

Percussionists will be charged an annual fee of \$25 to cover maintenance on school percussion equipment.

The rental fee covers basic annual maintenance of the school's instruments. It does not cover loss or damage due to negligence or accidents. If a school instrument is damaged due to negligence or an accident, the repair fee is the responsibility of the parent.

Expendables as required by each instrument (reeds, cleaning supplies, patch cables, drumsticks) are not covered in the annual rental fee. A method book is required for each student (approximately \$15). Expendables and method books are available for purchase locally through Wentworth Music or online through Tapestry Music in Vancouver.

Please note that Band 7 is a full-year commitment. Once the school schedule is created it is very difficult (and sometimes impossible) to move students from Band into another course!
